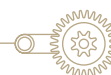
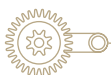
BEMUTATKOZÁS

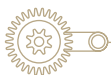
A borlap összeállításánál a legnagyobb kihívás, hogy mindenki megtalálja a számára megfelelő tételt. A FELIX borlapjának jelenlegi állapotát rengeteg előkészület, kóstolás és utazás előzte meg. Képviselni szeretnénk volna a világ klasszikus borvidékeit, ugyanakkor folyamatosan nyitott szemmel járunk, hogy ráakadjunk ismeretlen régiók izgalmas tételeire, amit méltónak találunk arra, hogy népszerűsítsünk a vendégeink körében.

A magyar borok mellett szeretnénk a világ klasszikus borvidékeit is reprezentálni. Egy mindenki által ismert klasszikus régiónál nem elégedtünk meg a jól ismert termelők tételeivel, nagy hangsúlyt helyezünk a kis pincék jelenlétére és az évjáratok változatosságára. A Sommelier csapat elsődleges feladata, hogy az igényeknek megfelelően tudják kalauzolni a vendéget a borvilág labirintusában. Nem azért vagyunk, hogy megmondjuk ki mit igyon hanem, hogy segítségünkkel mindenki megtalálja a számára különleges élményt nyújtó bort.

A Magyarországon fellelhető külföldi tételeknél korlátokba ütköztünk, ezért szorosan együtt működünk a Culinaris gasztronómiai nagykerrel, akik sokszor kizárólag a mi igényeinkre importálnak borokat. A borlapra soha nem fogjuk tudni azt mondani, hogy a munkát befejeztük. A világ bortermelő vidékei, a termelői stílusok, a felhasznált szőlőfajták évről évre változnak. Ez minket is folytonos munkára és kóstolásra készítet.

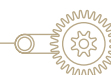
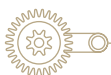
INTRODUCTION

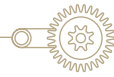
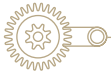
The biggest challenge when compiling a wine list is that it should include a wine for everyone. The current FELIX wine list entailed a lot of preparation, tasting and travel, as we wanted to present the world's classic wine regions, while also including exciting wines from unfamiliar regions we feel are worth promoting to our guests. Our wine list has been compiled so that it is exciting for those who consciously seek out their favourite region. However, at the same time, it aims to educate and encourage them to move out of their comfort zone.

As well as Hungarian wines, we also want to present the world's most distinguished wine regions. In the case of renowned classic wine regions, we not only look for wines from recognised producers, but also place great emphasis on the inclusion of up-and-coming winemakers. The range of vintages we offer is unique in Hungary, since for some iconic wines, we would like to give guests the opportunity to taste their favourite wine at different stages in its life.

The primary task of the Sommelier team is to guide guests, according to their needs, through the maze of the wine world. We are not here to tell you what to drink, but to help you find the right wine to ensure you have a special experience. We ran into restrictions on foreign wines in Hungary, so we created our own wholesale company called Culinaris to obtain wines we considered special directly and get them right from the cellar and onto our guests' tables. We will never be able to say that this job is complete, as the world's wine-producing regions, producer styles and grape varieties change every year. However, this also encourages us to keep our knowledge up-to-date and to taste constantly.

Cork naturally allows the perfect amount of oxygen to enter a bottle for the wine to age



When you remove a bottle's cork, the wine rapidly begins to oxidise.

HOW TO TELL IF OXYGEN HAS AFFECTED THE WINE

TOO MUCH OXYGEN OXIDISED



TOO LITTLE OXYGEN REDUCED

Fruit flavours and aromas are absent from the wine.

Eventually the wine will turn into vinegar.

Red wine turns brick red to brown, white wine turns golden brown.



Rotten egg, rubber and skunk aromas are present.

Wine will taste less 'bright' or seem less acidic.

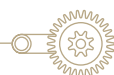
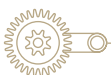

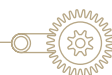
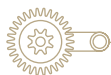


DRINKING WINE WITHOUT EXPOSING THE BOTTLE TO OXYGEN

The Coravin's needle allows you to pour a glass of wine without exposing the rest of the bottle to air.

Rapid oxidation is avoided. The wine in the bottle continues to age slowly as if it had never been opened.

SPARKLING WINE PRODUCTION

CUVÉE

After wines complete the first fermentation, the winemaker creates a blend, or *cuvée*, from a selection of base wines.

TIRAGE

Wines are bottled together with a small amount of a yeast and sugar/must mixture to initiate the 2nd fermentation. This mixture is called the *Liqueur de Tirage*.

AGEING

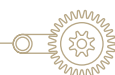
Wines age on the lees (dead yeast particles) for a period of time which lasts from about 9 months to 5 years (depending on quality level).

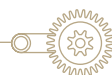
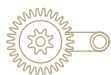
RIDDLING / DISGORGEMENT

The bottles are rotated so that the lees sink to the neck of the bottle. Then the bottle neck is placed in a frozen bath and opened in such a way that the frozen plug of lees shoots out.

DOSAGE

Some wine and sugar/must is added to the bottle. This mixture is also called the *liqueur d'expédition*.

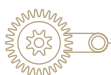
DOM PÉRIGNON

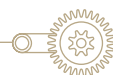
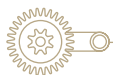
Dom Pierre Pérignon was a Benedictine monk who served as cellar master at the Abbey of Hautvillers from 1668 until his death in 1715. Many see him as the father of Champagne, although most of his life was spent trying to prevent bubble formation rather than promote it.

Many innovations are associated with his name, including blending wines to achieve higher quality or introducing cork to the region, while he was also the first to make white wine from black grapes. Champagne House Moët & Chandon, founded in 1773, named their prestige cuvée Dom Pérignon, synonymous with luxury since its debut in 1936 (1921 vintage), after him. Dom Pérignon is always a vintage Champagne and is usually 60% Chardonnay and 40% Pinot Noir, although proportions can vary from vintage to vintage. Dom Pérignon is usually aged for a minimum of 7 years instead of the 3 years required by law.

A rosé version of Dom Pérignon was introduced in 1959 and, besides many other notable occasions, celebrated the 2,500-year existence of the Persian Empire in 1971. In 2000, the winery introduced the Dom Pérignon "Oenothèque" label, which the cellar master matures on the lees for 15-20 years and can thus be presented to consumers in a different phase of maturity. This wine was renamed and so reborn as P2 or Plénitude in 2014. Dom Pérignon P3 was also launched the same year, showcasing a third life phase after more than 30 years of lees ageing.

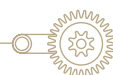
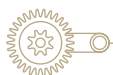

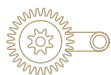
ESZENCIA

SZAMORODNI

A wine made without separating the aszú berries from normal grapes. The name basically translates as "made by itself" and requires less manual processing. Sweet > 45 g sugar /litre / Dry < 9g sugar/litre



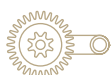


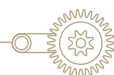

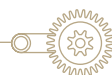
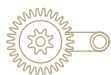
The Austrian region closest to our hearts is Wachau. It is an outstanding region for Grüner Veltliner and Riesling, which are classified into 3 categories:

Steinfeder: Wines with 11.5% alcohol or lower, made in a light, fruity style with crisp acidity, matured in stainless steel tank and released for early consumption.

Federspiel: Bottled at 11.5-12.5% alcohol, harvested with greater ripeness and characterised by ripe fruit, floral notes and underlying minerality.

Smaragd: All Riesling or Grüner Veltliner above 12.5% alcohol fall into this category. Made as dry wines with exceptional ripeness, resulting in higher alcohol and an oily texture, which is balanced by the naturally high acidity of the permitted grape varieties. Wines in this category are characterised by incredibly rich flavours and great complexity.

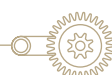


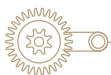

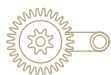
The Rousseau family, is definitely one of the greatest jewels of Burgundy. They have been always involved in the wine industry as merchants, cooperers or vigneronns.

The history in nutshell started with Armand Rousseau who received small plots of vineyard in 1909 as a wedding gift. He started estate bottling which gave him better control of the quality of his wines, and opportunity to export to the growing American market. He was followed by his son Charles in 1959 who continued building the export market and achieved worldwild acclaim to the domaine. Eric, his son, came on board in 1982 and his vision was to produce more sustainable wines. Eric's daughter Cyrille is different then the generations before her. She travelled the world and experienced different approaches to viticulture and winemaking, and currently Eric and Cyrille are working side by side to combine a traditional and modern winemaking and as a result to produce undoubtedly iconic wines.

Eric says there is no special recepe behind the quality of his wines. Old vines on the top vineyard sites, low yields and careful cultivation. The winemaking always adapts to the terroir and the vintage.

Clos Saint-Jacques- The Clos Saint Jacques is implicitly recognised as a Grand Cru, but was overlooked at the time of the official AOC Grand Cru classification. The vineyard faces south-east and benefits from maximum exposure to the sun, while its proximity to the Combe Lavaux keeps it cool.

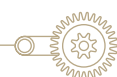
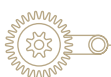
A handful of Tuscan winegrowers began experimenting with international grape varieties in the 1960s. Tuscany's coastal climate and soils favoured the Bordeaux varieties, and Marquis Mario Rocchetta began producing Sassicaia from his San Guido Estate in 1945 for his own and his family's consumption. The 1968 vintage was the first to be released commercially and was only referred to as "Super Tuscan" as it contained international grapes not permitted in the DOCG category, so was sold in the lower tier of "Vino da Tavola" or Table Wine.

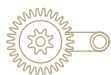
Encouraged by his success, his nephew Piero Antinori also made a blend of Sangiovese and the Cabernet varieties from the Tignanello Estate in the heart of the Chianti region, which he released as Tignanello from the 1971 vintage. The estate also produces another iconic wine called Solaia from one of the Tignanello Estate's warmest vineyards, where Cabernet Sauvignon, which is then blended with Sangiovese, has no trouble ripening. This wine has dazzled wine lovers since 1978.

Another member of the Antinori family, Piero's younger brother Ludovico Antinori, founded Tenuta dell'Ornellaia after visiting California and meeting André Tschlisheff, the mentor of Robert Mondavi and Joe Heitz, among others. Ornellaia, first released with the 1985 vintage, was a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Franc and Merlot. A 100% Merlot, first bottled in 1986 as an experiment on the Tenuta dell'Ornellaia Estate, was named "Massi", Masseto, after the blue clay soil in the vineyards. Tibor Gál Sr also played a role on the Tenuta dell'Ornellaia Estate, helping with the winemaking from the 1990s and winning the Wine Spectator magazine's Top 100 in 2001 with the 1998 vintage.

50&50 is a hybrid wine, comprising 50% Merlot and 50% Sangiovese, resulting from a close relationship between the Avignonesi Estate in Montepulciano and the Capannelle Winery in Chianti.

The rise of the Super Tuscans was based on these wines, but the story does not end here, as their success inspired other winemakers in the region. Baffonero, a single varietal Merlot and the result of the joint work of renowned Chianti producer Castellare and Bordeaux icon Château Lafite, has become Masseto's biggest rival.



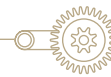
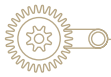
